JOB DESCRIPTION – Peer Support Worker

Reports to: Peer Support Program Coordinator or, in their absence, the RCFC Executive Director.

Overview: The Peer Support Worker is responsible for supporting matched clients in achieving their goals within the community and/or providing outreach and support to patients in acute health care settings.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work collaboratively in a team environment with other employees and health care professionals.
- Support clients by discussing goals and communicating feedback to case managers or other health care professionals.
- Assist clients in identifying barriers and developing actionable strategies to empower themselves through self-determination.
- Attend bi-weekly payroll/debriefing meetings, record hours and expenses, and ensure client-related issues are safeguarded with the utmost confidentiality.
- Fill out timesheets and keep receipts for expenses for reimbursement.
- Engage in mentoring from the Program Coordinator and participate in professional development, education, and training opportunities.
- Be available for referrals to the next available "best-matched" client and maintain scheduled appointments.
- Keep statistical records and complete evaluations and other required notes.
- Adhere to all program regulations, policies, and procedures.

Skills and Knowledge:

- Act as a role model for individuals recovering from severe mental illness, maintaining a preventative self-care model and effective stress management strategies.
- Work with a diverse population with empathy, patience, and support.
- Present professionally in all interactions.
- Possess strong interpersonal skills such as conflict resolution, handling challenging behaviors, diplomacy, and teamwork.
- Promote and provide information about other RCFC programs and opportunities to clients and patients.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Completion of a recognized peer support training program renewed every five years.
- Lived experience as a mental health consumer within the mental health system.

Position Details:

- Part-time position, 6-10 hours bi-weekly, Monday to Friday, during daytime hours.
- Wage rate: \$22 per hour, with paid sick time and vacation.
- Work locations: In-person at various sites in the Richmond community, Vancouver Coastal Health acute health care settings, and, if needed, virtually (via Zoom) from home.
