

Marketing Guide for CIF Project Leaders

CIF Project leaders are responsible for creating all marketing material (posters, graphics, etc). Marketing material must be reviewed and approved by CIF prior to distribution.

CIF can distribute approved posters/graphics via:

- Spotlight Mailing List
- Social Media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter) - Each social media platform has specific requirements. Please contact CIF Coordinator for more details

Poster/graphics must include:

- CIF logo (minimum width 0.75 inch, 1.9 cm, or 100 pixels)
- Project Name
- Location
- Date and Time
- How to register/sign up
- Contact info for questions

When to send out marketing?

- Can start distribution up to 4-6 weeks prior to event date
- **Must submit marketing material to CIF at least 3 weeks before event date**
 - Please allow 1 week for CIF review and approval
 - Must be sent out at least 2 weeks before event date

Written description:

Not all information can fit on a poster/graphic, so please include a brief description. Details may vary depending on specific project, but typically answer the following questions:

- Who can apply? Ex: "Open to those with lived/living experience of mental health and/or substance use challenges. Priority is given to Vancouver residents"
- How much does it cost? (Participation in CIF projects is always free!)
- What is involved in the project activities?
- How will a participant benefit from taking part? What will they learn or experience?

When submitting marketing materials to CIF, please include the following information:

- What platforms? Spotlight Mailing List, Instagram, Facebook, Twitter
- What is the distribution date?
- Do you want any reminders to go out? How many times?
- Hashtags (if using social media platforms)
